Afilon President Charles Vela to Present at Prestigious 4th Annual NDIA Stability, Security, Transition, and Reconstruction Conference

The four featured presenters on the panel will be examining climate change, natural disasters, trans-national narco-terrorism, fragile and failing states, multiple small-scale wars, high rates of unemployment, population explosions, disease outbreaks, and terrorist attacks on various homelands (e.g. Oslo, Madrid, 9-11). They will discuss if recent events are an indicator of the coming decade. Along with these challenges, can America continue to expect new developments in technology, political climates, and alliances. What new policies and practices, tools and techniques will the government need to develop in order to adapt and manage these issues, including gender-based violence, narco-trafficking, and money laundering.
